

# The PMFD Firefighter *Signature* scavenger hunt!



## OFFICIAL RULES

(Subject to change until start of event)

1. Purchase your **Scavenger Hunt Kit** at the *First Responder Chaplain Corps* tent.
2. Be sure you're registered **and** your start time recorded by an FRCC representative.
3. There are two parts of the hunt...
  1. Review photos of the firefighters in the SmokeEater's book and addendum and if they're at the open house, have them **sign their name** by their photo! Not all firefighters will be present at open house. Only one signature per firefighter counts.
  2. Locate the tools, apparatus, and other items listed in the addendum and record the number, located on the **Official Tag\***, in the addendum.
4. When you're done, go back to the FRCC tent and...
  1. Have your "end time" recorded
  2. Turn in your addendum **and** have the signatures in your book checked and recorded for points - you keep the SmokeEater's book!
5. Kit with the most points wins! If there's a tie, the kit with the most points **and** shortest time wins.
6. All completed kits must be recorded at the FRCC tent by the close of open house to be eligible. Late submissions will not be accepted.
7. The winner will not be announced that day, but will be contacted after the open house and announced on social media.

### IMPORTANT:

1. Some items are worth more points than others, as indicated. If not indicated, item is worth one (1) point.
2. **Mystery Items:** We have preselected some firefighters or items to be worth more points than others, but the amount of points is a mystery!
3. You can ask PMFD firefighters for help in identifying items!
4. We are not responsible should a firefighter or apparatus leave for a call.



\*This is what an Official Tag looks like. They're attached to the items listed in the addendum. There is only one (1) item per tag. You might find several shovels, but only **one** has an official tag on it - it's a scavenger hunt! Keep hunting!

**Do NOT remove the tags from items they're attached to!**
